This results in:

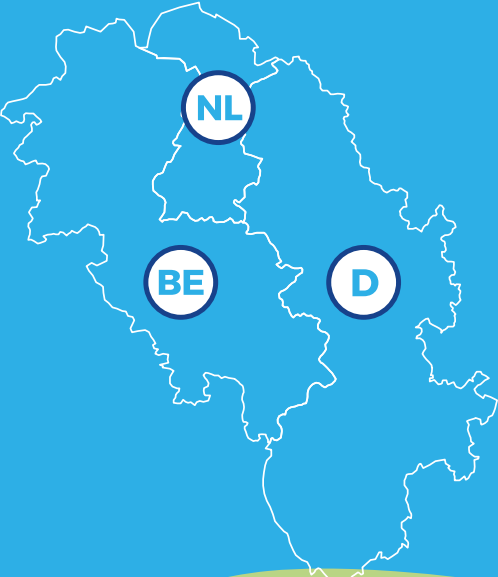
